Your cooperation will be greatly appreciated because it makes our job easier and snow removal can be done in a more timely fashion. Also be reminded that it is difficult for truck drivers to see what is behind them, especially at intersections, and to minimize the risk of being backed into, we recommend you stay back a minimum of 500 feet.

# TAX COLLECTOR

Ligonier Township spring property taxes (County and Township) will be mailed March 1, 2010. Discount amount will be honored through April 30th, face amount through June 30th and penalty amount through December 31, 2010. Ligonier Township fall property taxes (School) will be mailed August 1, 2010, Discount amount will be honored through September 30th. face amount through November 30th and penalty amount through December 31, 2010. All payments must be accompanied with a tax statement. If a receipt is requested, please include a self addressed, stamped return envelope. Tax statements are no longer mailed to the mortgage companies. Tax statements are mailed to the taxpayer. If applicable, please forward your statement to the mortgage company for prompt payment. Failure to receive a tax statement does not relieve the taxpayer of the responsibility of payment. If you do not receive a tax statement, please contact the tax office. Payments made December 1st through December 31st must be paid with a certified check, cashiers check or money order. A drop-off slot is available at the tax collectors office to accept payment before or after normal business hours. Please keep your addresses updated with the tax office.


