The Ligonier Valley Police Department (LVPD) is currently accepting applications to fill one full time Patrol Officer vacancy and will be creating an applicant eligibility list for future hiring.

LVPD is a regional department serving approximately 8,000 residents in both the Ligonier Borough and Ligonier Township. The Township completely surrounds the Borough covering 93 square miles. Four major highways – SR 30, 711, 259 and 271 run through LVPD's jurisdiction. Ligonier is part of the Laurel Highlands and the area's main industry is tourism; there are golf courses, museums, the Laurel Mountain ski resort, Idlewild amusement park and the region's largest outdoor market. Ligonier frequently makes Country Living's "most charming small towns" list.

The LVPD's current minimum is two officers per shift and the department currently employs two School Resource Officers, a Firearms and Taser Instructor, a K9 Unit and an Accident Reconstructionist. There are seven patrol vehicles kept on a fleet maintenance schedule, all vehicles are equipped with in-car cameras, computers, printers and scanners. The department has a body-worn camera program and utilizes Informant to track incidents and arrests.
