

Ligonier Township Supervisors

Special Meeting

21 January 2011

The Supervisors of Ligonier Township met in special session at 2 pm for the purpose of conducting general business. Present were Chairman William C Penrod Jr and Keith A Whipkey. Timothy R Komar was absent.

Supervisors heard a site plan request for Rolling Rock Club to add a Shooting Lodge addition onto the facility. The purpose of the addition is to expand the uses of the current structure. Representative of Rolling Rock, Attorney George Welty, was present to explain the specifics. A Planning Commission review indicated stipulations should be attached to the approval. A motion was made by Whipkey and seconded by Penrod to approve the expansion with the provisions that (1) no food be prepared on-site, and (2) no changes to the plan are to be made without coming back to the Township for further review.

Motion carried.

A motion was made by Whipkey and seconded by Penrod to hire Brett Markle as an on-call, part-time police officer at the current rate of pay and effective immediately. Motion carried.

There being no further business brought before the Supervisors at this time, a motion was made by Whipkey and seconded by Penrod to adjourn the meeting at 2:07 pm. Motion carried.
