- List of areas in the zoning code that need updated.
 - Update from Scott Gongaware, regarding Zoning Hearing Board concern with approving billboard on 271. General objectives do not match specific provisions in zoning code. Concern about too many billboards, without enough restrictions on things like lighting. No specificity on number of lumens. Discussion about advertising billboards versus identification signs. Can the Township restrict to local businesses only? Perhaps the Commission should address additional issues, not just signage being proactive, not just reactive. For example: tiny houses, marijuana dispensaries, non-conforming lots (on zoning map). Discussion about best practices, and language in zoning codes of other municipalities.
 - Motion made to recommend the board of supervisors impose a moratorium of new billboards, subject to a legal opinion. Made by Sheila Grimm, seconded by Susan McBroom, motion passes unanimously.
