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Chapter A121

CREATION OF TOWNSHIP OF LIGONIER

Order of Court on petition for the formation of a new Township out of the adjoining parts of Donegal to Fairfield Township.

May Session 1822

Westmoreland County

In the Court of General Quarter Session of the peace for said County in the borough of Greensburgh of August Session 1821.

Upon the Petition of sundry inhabitants of Fairfield and Donegal Township in said County stating that in consequence of the largeness of Fairfield and Donegal Township in Ligonier Valley it has in their opinion become necessary that a new Township should be erected out of the adjoining parts of the two aforesaid Townships either of which the petitioners state embraces a distance of twenty to twenty five miles in length and from ten to twelve miles breadth and are altogether too large for convenience and praying the Court to take measurements so that a new Township may be struck off of the adjoining parts out of the two aforesaid Townships. The Court appoint James McClean Esqr. Adam Clark Esqr. Col. Jacob D. Mathoil to inquire into the property of granting the prayer of the petitioner and in case be satisfied thereof to make a plot or draft of the new Township and report the proceedings at the next session.

November Session 1821 on application for a renewal of the above order and hearing a remonstrance against the divers in prayer for the Court hold the same under consideration until next Session.

And now February Session 1822- The court on further consideration appoint Joseph Baldrige in the place D. Mathoil who with the others two above named are to view and to inquire as above directed & report to the next session.

In pursuance of the above order of Court we the subscribers set at the house of Henry Ankeny of Liginior Town on the seventh day of May – Instance and Proceeded to view the two Townships of Fairfield and Donegal in Westmoreland County and taking into consideration the prayerse for forming a third township out of the townships aforesaid Beg leave to report to the Court as follows that we consider that the inhabitants of said Townships labor under great inconviences for want of being divided, And we think the division lines as laid down on the Plot to be the most convienent place for a division.

Some of the “Ligonier” accepted roads may refer to Ligonier Borough, either because the roads were accepted prior to the borough’s secession, or due to record keepers at the county not differentiating between “boro” and “twp.” Some “Ligonier” roads may also refer to Cook Township roads, as Cook was formerly part of Ligonier Township.
